Abstract	<p>As provided by the Conservation and Management Measure for the Establishment of a Southern Indian Ocean Fisheries Agreement (SIOFA) Compliance Monitoring Scheme (CMM 11(2020) Compliance Monitoring Scheme), the Secretariat has prepared a draft SIOFA Compliance Report (dSCR), that also considers input received from CCPs, on their section of the dSCR.</p> <p>To facilitate the work of the Compliance Committee, the dSCR is also accompanied by a summarized table of potential compliance issues as identified by the Secretariat.
