<b>Abstract</b>	<p>In accordance with CMM 06 (2022), the SIOFA draft IUU vessels list has been prepared for consideration by the 8th Meeting of the Compliance Committee (CC08), so that they can either include the vessels on the Provisional IUU Vessel List, or request the removal of vessels from the Draft IUU Vessels list. The Draft IUU list contain only one vessel (IMULA 1844 MTR), with additional information provided by its flag state during the Intersessional Period.</p> <p><b>Rev1 of this document considers the response of the flag state following notification sent from the Secretariat regarding its flagged vessel being listed on the draft SIOFA IUU Vessels List, and the flag states response to additional information requested by CCPs after the transmission of the Draft SIOFA IUU Vessels list.</b></p>

### Recommendations

The CC08 to take note of the vessel included on the Draft IUU Vessel list, including the new information provided by its Flag State during the Intersessional Period, and recommend either its inclusion on the SIOFA Provisional IUU Vessel list or its removal from the Draft IUU Vessel list.
