Abstract	

In accordance with Regulation 3.5 of the Financial Regulations of the Meeting of the Parties (2022) please find below the draft SIOFA 2025 budget.

The SIOFA 2025 draft budget has been prepared in two parts: The first part sets out details of each item and sub-item included in the draft budget estimate. The purpose of this document is to justify the figures proposed for the 2025 draft budget. The second part presents the compiled budget proposal for 2025, a forecast for 2026, and an estimate of the forecast contributions for 2025, based on the elements known to the Secretariat as of 20 April 2024. This repartition grid will be updated according to the budget adopted by the MoP and the catches declared by each CCP on 31 May 2024.

Some comments and information received have required an update of this provisional budget for 2025. The changes and/or contributions made are highlighted in yellow.
