Abstract

Following discussions at the Seventh Meeting of the Compliance Committee of the Southern Indian Ocean Fisheries Agreement (CCO7), the CC and the MoP agreed to continue discussions related to a new CCP Compliance Report (CCR) Template intersessionally based on the two templates that were presented to the committee. To recap, there were two proposed methods for the assessment of some of the obligations in the SIOFA CMMs, which suggests the establishment of relevant domestic measures by CCPs to ensure compliance by intended subjects (vessels, nationals, ports, etc..). CCPs may further recall discussions related to the assessment criteria for these obligations, where there was no agreed consensus on the assessment criteria, and consequently the CCR template to be used for the collection of data on compliance, for assessment by the Compliance Committee.

Following this, CCPs convened twice to discuss and agree on a new CCR template for use during the next compliance assessment process. The proposed templates draws from comments received during and after the two meetings. The template being proposed to the CC08 should maintain the current level of reporting for obligations that requires implementation of domestic measures, eliminates the need to report on such measures annually unless there has been changes to these measures or to the CMM, and other improvements suggested by CCPs

The document was considered by the CC08, and it endorsed the template as the new template, while proposing that the Secretariat include a field for CCPs to include a reason when they select a status of "not applicable".
