In accordance with Paragraph 5 of CMM 11 (2020) on the Compliance Monitoring Scheme, CC09 and MoP12 are tasked with reviewing any additional recommendations made by the Meeting of the Parties in previous years' Final Compliance Reports. This review aims to assess the extent to which these recommendations have been implemented by the relevant Contracting Parties (CCPs), the Compliance Committee, the Meeting of the Parties, or the Secretariat, as appropriate, including any associated follow-up actions. This paper outlines the recommendations endorsed by MoP11 and provides an update on their current implementation status.

Review of Recommendations of the 11th Meeting of the Parties (MoP11) on the SIOFA Final SIOFA Compliance Report (fSCR)

Summary

Paragraph 5 of the <u>Conservation and Management Measure for the Establishment of a Southern</u> <u>Indian Ocean Fisheries Agreement (SIOFA) Compliance Monitoring Scheme</u> requires that the Compliance Committee and the Meeting of the Parties review recommendations made by the Meeting of the Parties in previous years' Final Compliance Reports (fSCR). This review serves to assess how these recommendations have been implemented by the relevant Contracting Parties (CCPs), the Compliance Committee, the Meeting of the Parties, or the Secretariat, as appropriate, including any related follow-up action

The 11th Meeting of the Parties endorsed six (6) recommendations from the fSCR, including three (3) follow-up actions required by CCPs regarding identified compliance issues.

Table 1 below shows a summary of the recommendation and its status at the time of submitting this paper.³ and recommended follow-up action for these pending actions to the MoP12 by CC09.
