Abstract	<p>In accordance with the Conservation and Management Measure for the Establishment of a Southern Indian Ocean Fisheries Agreement (SIOFA) Compliance Monitoring Scheme (CMM 11(2020)), the Secretariat has prepared the draft SIOFA Compliance Report (dSCR). The report incorporates comments and information submitted by CCPs regarding their respective sections of the dSCR. The compliance assessment covers the Assessment Period of 1 January – 31 December 2025, inclusive.</p> <p>For this year's compliance assessment, the Secretariat received CCPs' Compliance Reports (CCRs) from all CCPs. However, two CCPs submitted their CCRs after the established deadline of 7 May 2026. Furthermore, two CCPs did not provide comments on their respective sections of the dSCR. Although commenting on the draft report is voluntary, such input is an important part of the review process, as it enables the Secretariat to consider additional information, clarifications, and corrections prior to finalising the dSCR.</p> <p>To facilitate the work of the Compliance Committee, the dSCR is preceded by a consolidated summary of potential compliance issues identified by the Secretariat based on the information available at the time of the assessment. The Secretariat has also included an Excel version of the dSCR on the meeting page to facilitate reference by CCPs, the Compliance Committee and the Meeting of the Parties in their consideration of the dSCR.</p>
