<p>Pursuant to paragraph 12 (b) of CMM 06 (2024), the Compliance Committee is required to consider the current SIOFA IUU Vessel List and recommend to the MoP which vessels, if any, should be removed from it.</p> <p>The Current SIOFA IUU Vessels List was updated intersessionally to include updates from the North Pacific Fisheries Commission (Intersessional Cross Listing Procedure through Circular N° 2025-22), the South Pacific Regional Fisheries Management Organisation, & the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission (Intersessional Cross Listing Procedure through Circular N° 2026-06)</p> <p><i>It is to be noted that the Secretariat did not receive any request to remove any vessels on the current SIOFA IUU Vessels list for consideration by the Compliance Committee, and subsequently by the Meeting of the Parties.</i></p>
