Abstract	<p>Pursuant to paragraph 12 (b) of CMM 06 (2024), the Compliance Committee is required to consider the current SIOFA IUU Vessel List and recommend to the MoP which vessels, if any, should be removed from it.</p> <p>The Current SIOFA IUU Vessels List was updated intersessionally to include updates from the North Pacific Fisheries Commission (Intersessional Cross Listing Procedure through Circular N° 2025-22), the South Pacific Regional Fisheries Management Organisation, & the Indian Ocean Tuna Commission (Intersessional Cross Listing Procedure through Circular N° 2026-06).</p> <p><i>It is to be noted that the Secretariat did not receive any request to remove any vessels on the current SIOFA IUU Vessels list for consideration by the Compliance Committee and, subsequently, by the Meeting of the Parties.</i></p> <p><i>Rev 1 of this document includes comments received from one CCP regarding changes in the IUU lists of other RFMOS, not reflected in the Current SIOFA IUU Vessels list. These updates were received after the circulation of the Current IUU Vessels list and the publication of this document.</i></p>

Recommendations

- That the CC **notes** that there has been no request to remove a vessel from the [Current SIOFA IUU Vessels List](#).
- That the CC **notes** the omitted changes in the Current SIOFA IUU vessels list with respect to vessels cross-listed from other RFMOs, and that the CC **recommends** that these changes be incorporated into the Current SIOFA IUU Vessels list.
- That the MoP **endorses** these recommendations and **agrees** that these changes be incorporated in the Current SIOFA IUU Vessels list at the conclusion of MoP13.

Proposed Modifications to the Current SIOFA IUU Vessels list

The following modifications are being proposed to the SIOFA's current IUU Vessels list to update the information related to a number of vessels currently cross-listed on it:

- Update to the flag of FREEDOM 7 from CAMEROON to UNKNOWN
- Delisting of the vessel FU HSIANG FA, as it was removed from the GFCM IUU Vessel List in 2024.
- HE LI 1 HAO: IOTC IUU vessel list (originating RFMO) provides additional details for this vessel, IMO N°: 8524492, and the previous name of the vessel, SINAR ABADI 69.
- OCEAN STAR N°2: ICCAT IUU vessel list (originating RFMO) provides additional details for this vessel, IMO N°: 8665193
- TA FU 1: ICCAT IUU vessel list (originating RFMO) provides additional details for this vessel, IMO N°: 9259070.
